VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:

Below you will find specific areas to serve within the Adventure Co.

Lead Teacher: Provides leadership and support to a team of four to five small group leaders and oversees the classroom on Sunday morning. Usually tells the main bible story during the lessons.

Assistant: Is a part of the lesson each week, usually acts as the "comic relief" for the bible story by acting out skits and getting the kids involved (ex: dressing as a cowboy and having an arm wrestling match with the kids). The assistant is someone who is out-going and not afraid to act silly and connect with kids on their level.

Worship Leader/Team: Picks out praise and worship songs appropriate for K-5 students. Will rehearse, teach and lead (musically and spiritually) the kids each week during their time of worship.

Small Group Leader: serves as the primary role model for the same group of six to eight kids on a weekly basis. Examples of what makes a great small group leader for kids:

1. Caring adult cheering them on.
2. Encouragement to grow spiritually on their own.
3. Support during difficult times in their life.
4. Presence at their sporting events.
5. Someone who is excited to see them at church.
6. Someone they are excited to see when they arrive at church.
7. Someone who leaves them voice messages "just because I was thinking of you."
8. A caring adult who doesn't freak-out over bad grades--they're capable of being neutral.
9. Someone who is a "safe" person to talk to.
10. A person who is tender, yet truthful when kids need a little correcting.

Greeter: Greets families and children as they enter and guides them through the entire process of checking into class.
